PREAMBLE:

SUBJECT: Economic Opportunity Funding Requests

Purpose:

To summarize details related to an Economic Funding Request.

Discussion:

The purpose of the funding is to assist the District of Sicamous (DOS) with the final cost for the purchase and installation of outdoor lighting along Highway 97A in a treed pathway.

The total project costs have increased to be approximately \$200,000. The original budget was \$100,000 with \$75,000 of this being funded from Economic Opportunity Funding (this was approved back in the 2014 year). Due to the length of time since the original project budget and EOF approval (4 years) the scope and design has changed resulting in an increase in the overall project costs. The DOS is asking for funding of \$100,000 to cover the remaining project costs.

Attached is a map showing where the lighting will be along the Highway. Due to their highly visible Highway location, many travelers will see the lighting which will draw their eye towards Sicamous and the downtown core. This lighting ties directly to the newly constructed and lighted roundabout and will have a significant "wow" factor to the entrance to the community and have travelers notice, which will assist in the "look" and "feel" of Sicamous and the surrounding area. This will encourage more visitors to the area and result in more tourism. The visually appealing lighting will also have a positive impact to any potential investors or developers, which directly stimulates economic development.

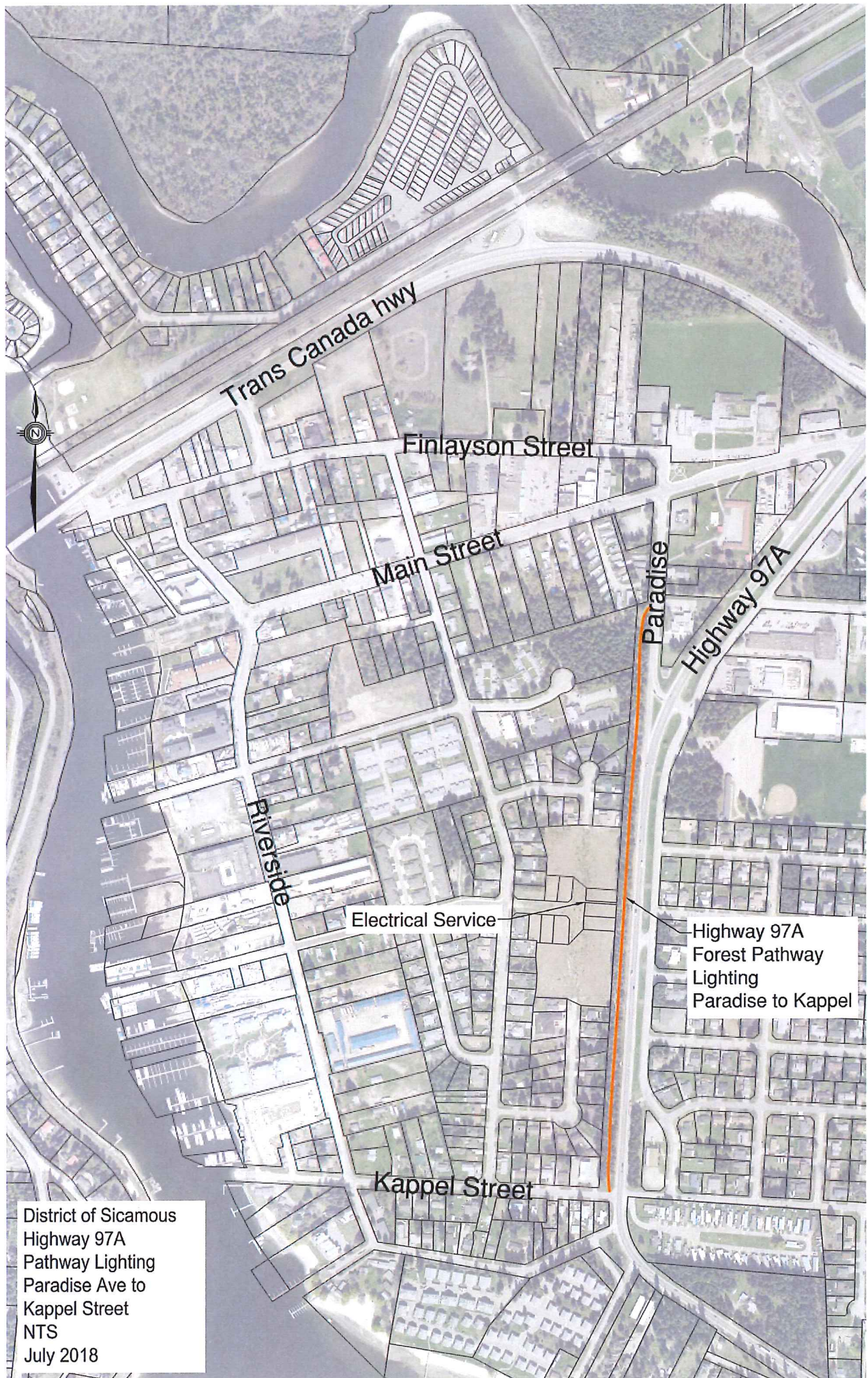
