At high water, it's only about 7' deep off the end of my 40' long dock with 8' long walkway. In August it's only at most 4' deep off the end of the dock. If you limit the length of the dock to anything shorter than 40' plus a walkway, I will have to be out of compliance just to have a dock that's barely long enough to be able to dock a wakeboard boat with a propeller underneath and to even have 4' of depth off the deep end of it for more than half the summer. I don't like the idea of having a shorter dock and a longer walkway because that puts too much stress on the connecting hardware during storms. A longer dock with a shorter walkway is way stronger and more durable in storms which can bring some pretty big waves where I am. Your proposed max dock length and area is too small to be workable in some areas of the lake. I have to have a dock that's at least 40' long plus a walkway to get any depth at the end of the dock during the last 5 or so weeks of the summer so I will never comply with any rule that forces me to have a shorter dock and I will fight it to the highest court if I have to. important than the size.
