BACKGROUND:

Corporate

In November 2017, the Board approved five-year funding in the amount of \$60,000 per year for a five year term using Economic Opportunity Fund. The facility houses several important tenants which provide economic benefit to the community. The building currently houses the Learning Academy, the Post Office, the community library, the Eagle Valley Community Support Society and the Community Resource Centre. In addition, there is rental space for community groups, weddings, and meetings, as well as a gymnasium which is utilized by community wellness groups.

In the Lease Agreement with the school district, the Malakwa Community Learning Centre is required to pay for insurance and utilities as well as to contribute to capital reserves for the replacement of both the HVAC and the roof. This required funding amount varies annually depending on things such as snow fall and the roof needing to be shovelled and/or problems with the building. Rent is collected from the Malakwa Post Office and the Eagle Valley Community Support Society various community functions for expenses such as janitorial and maintenance, however, a stable funding source is required for the financial commitment to the School District.

POLICY:

This request meets the criteria for support in relation to CSRD Policy *F-29, BC Hydro Payments -in-Lieu of Taxes* funding assistance to stimulate economic development within the Sicamous/Area E area.

FINANCIAL:

The approximate balance of the Sicamous/Area E EOF (less commitments) as of June 30, 2022 was \$457,000. The estimated 2022 distribution of \$256,000 is due to be received in July 2022 and is included in the approximate balance.

IMPLEMENTATION:

Upon Board and District of Sicamous approval, EOF funds will be made available as required by the Malakwa Community Learning Centre.

COMMUNICATIONS:

The District of Sicamous and the Malakwa Community Learning Centre will be advised of the Board's decision.
